Transfer Articulation Agreement between Bunker Hill Community College and Boston College Woods College of Advancing Studies for the Associate of Science degree in Criminal Justice Transfer Option to the Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal & Social Justice, on campus or hybrid.

Date Established: Spring 2023

Eligibility:

1. Students must complete the Associate of Science degree in Criminal Justice Transfer Option at BHCC with an overall grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
2. Students must meet all application requirements, including official transcripts from all previously attended institutions. Student do not need to submit an application fee, essay or letters of recommendation.
3. Students must receive a 'C' or higher for a course to transfer. WCAS will accept up to 60 transfer credits, which will apply toward Bachelor degree completion.
