## MEDICAL IMAGING (MI) PROGRAMS

### Application Dates for Fall 2018: October 2, 2017 – February 16, 2018

Full-Time Cardiac Sonography Option – 24 months in duration

Full-Time General Sonography Option – 24 months in duration

Full-Time Medical Radiography Option – 21 months in duration

Part-Time Medical Radiography Option – 35 months in duration

### Admissions Process

- Complete the BHCC application online. Submit proof of high school completion (or its equivalency) by uploading one of the items below:
  - A copy of high school transcript or diploma
  - A copy of passing GED or HiSET results
- After completing the application, please submit prerequisite documents to the Admissions Office.
- Attend a [mandatory information session](#).
- **Admission into the Medical Imaging program is based on a scoring system that includes student performance on the TEAS VI, as well as academic performance in the prerequisite courses.**

### Admissions Requirements for the Medical Imaging Program

- Attach a copy of MANDATORY information session confirmation
- Complete the following courses with a grade C or better and submit an unofficial or official transcript\*:
  - One semester of College Algebra (Mat 193 or Mat 194) or any 3 credit college algebra
  - One semester of College level BIO 203, Anatomy and Physiology I /Lab (must be completed within five years of application unless currently working in related healthcare position)\*\*
  - One semester of College Writing I (ENG 111) or equivalent with a grade of C or better
- Complete TEAS VI exam by **February 16, 2018**
  - Please visit <http://www.atitesting.com> to register. You will need to create an account to register for and complete the exam. Applicants are not required to take the TEAS test at BHCC; you may register for any location. The test is designated as TEAS Nursing.
  - If an applicant has taken the TEAS VI test twice within a 12 month period prior to application, the highest scores on the same TEAS VI admission test will be used for admission decisions. A maximum of 2 tests taken during the 12 month period will be reviewed. If staff is provided with more than 2 within the 12 month period, only the 2 latest will be considered.
  - Applicants must score at least 47.6 percent on reading, 46.7 percent in math, and 47.6 percent in English/Language on the TEAS VI to be considered for the Medical Imaging Program
  - Applicants who have previously completed a degree must upload their college transcripts to their application, and will also receive an additional point during the selection process.

\* Applicants who submit unofficial transcripts will need to request an official transcript to receive transfer credit

\*\*Applicants who have applicable work experience must submit a letter on letterhead from their supervisor, and will receive an additional point during the selection process
