Admissions Requirements for the Medical Imaging Program

- Attendance at a mandatory information session
- Complete the following courses with a grade C or better and submit an unofficial or official transcript*:
 - One semester of College Algebra (Mat 193 or Mat 194) or any math course that is equivalent to MAT 193 or MAT 194 (please confirm math equivalency with admissions before taking a course outside of BHCC)
 - One semester of College level BIO 203, Anatomy and Physiology I /Lab (must be completed within five years of application unless currently working in related healthcare position)**
 - One semester of College Writing I (ENG 111) or equivalent with a grade of C or better
- Complete TEAS VI exam by **February 15, 2019**
 - Please visit <http://www.atitesting.com> to register. You will need to create an account to register for and complete the exam. Applicants are not required to take the TEAS test at BHCC; you may register for any location. The test is designated as TEAS Nursing.
 - If an applicant has taken the TEAS VI test twice within a 12 month period prior to application, the highest scores on the same TEAS VI admission test will be used for admission decisions. A maximum of 2 tests taken during the 12 month period will be reviewed. If staff is provided with more than 2 within the 12 month period, only the 2 latest will be considered.
 - Applicants must score at least 47.6 percent on reading, 46.7 percent in math, and 47.6 percent in English/Language on the TEAS VI to be considered for the Medical Imaging Program
 - Applicants who have previously completed a degree must upload their college transcripts to their application, and will also receive an additional point during the selection process.

Admissions Process

- Complete the Selective BHCC application for Fall 2019 [online](#). Submit proof of high school completion (or its equivalency) by uploading one of the items below:
 - A copy of high school transcript or diploma
 - A copy of passing GED or HiSET results
- After completing the application, please submit all application materials to the Admissions Office.

Admission into the Medical Imaging program is based on a scoring system that includes student performance on the TEAS VI, as well as academic performance in the prerequisite courses.

* Applicants who submit unofficial transcripts will need to request an official transcript to receive transfer credit

**Applicants who have applicable work experience must submit a letter on letterhead from their supervisor, and will receive an additional point during the selection process
