



Upload an Adobe Presenter Presentation to Moodle by Drag and Drop

Introduction

The following tutorial will demonstrate how to upload an Adobe Presenter presentation to Moodle using Firefox or Google Chrome. This tutorial assumes that you have already published your Adobe Presenter Presentation to a PDF file.

Upload a Published Presentation to Moodle

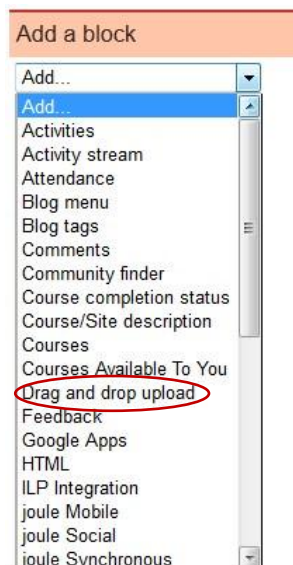
Step 1: To begin, click on the **Turn editing on** after you have logged into your course.



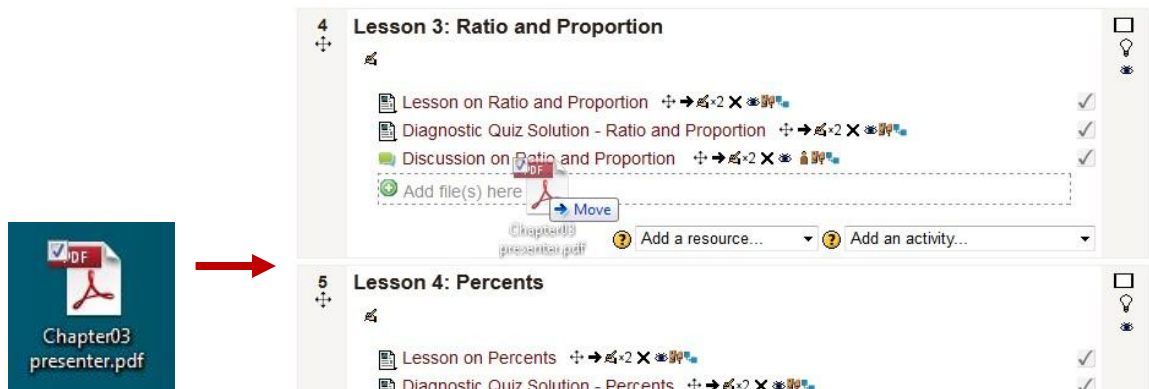
Step 2: Next, Click **Add...** on the “Add a block” block. The drop-down menu will appear.



Step 3: Click on the **Drag and drop upload**.



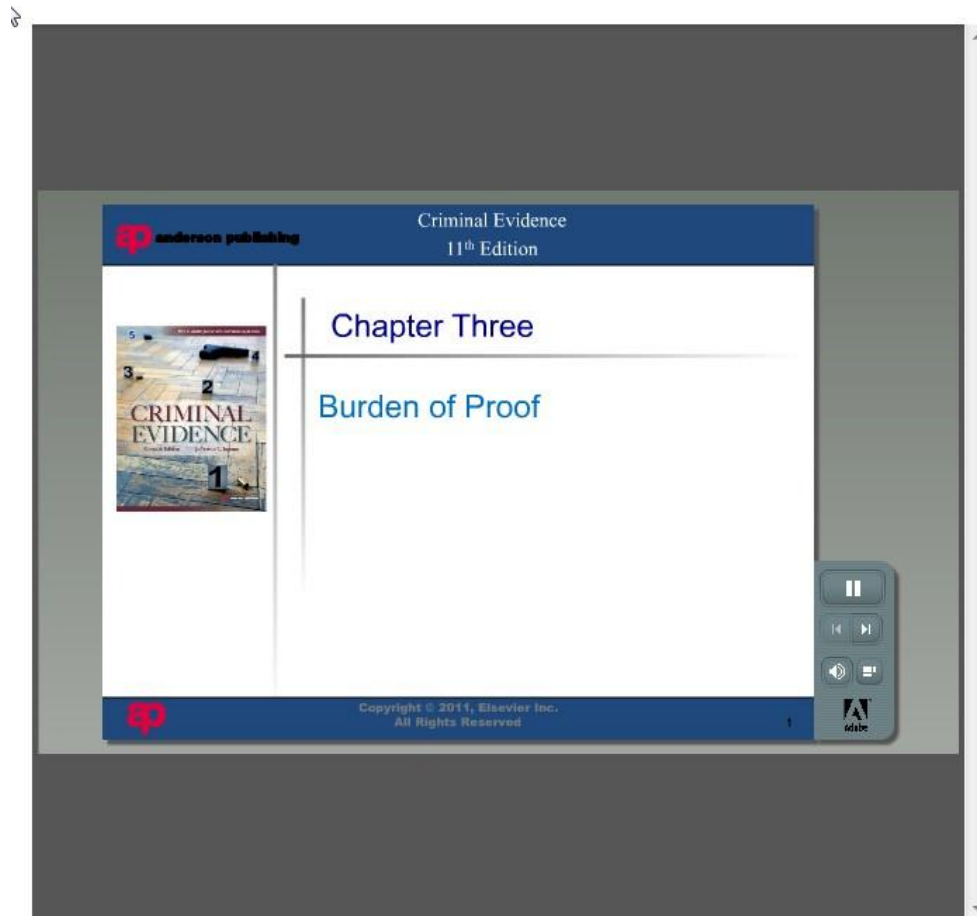
Step 4: Next locate the PDF presenter file and drag it onto the course topic. In this example, we will drag the **Chapter03 presenter.pdf** onto **Lesson 3: Ratio and Proportion topic**.



Note: This feature **does not** available when using the **Internet Explorer** Browser.

The file will automatically upload to **Lesson 3: Ratio and Proportion**
