Eligibility:

- 1. Students must complete the Associate of Science degree in Criminal Justice Career Option at BHCC with an overall grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- 2. Students must meet all application requirements, including official transcripts from all previously attended institutions. Student do not need to submit an application fee, essay or letters of recommendation.
- 3. Students must receive a 'C' or higher for a course to transfer. WCAS will accept up to 60 transfer credits, which will apply toward Bachelor degree completion.
