Transfer Articulation Agreement between Bunker Hill Community College and Northeastern University College of Professional Studies for the Associate of Science degree in Accounting to the Bachelor of Science degree in Finance and Accounting Management, on campus or online.

Date Established: Fall 2021

Eligibility:

1. Students must complete the Associate of Science degree in Accounting at BHCC with an overall grade point average of 2.0 or higher.
2. Students must meet all application requirements, including official transcripts from all previously attended institutions. Student do not need to submit an application fee, essay or letters of recommendation.
3. Students must receive a 'C' or higher in order for a course to transfer. Northeastern will accept up to 66 transfer credits.
