Scope and Contents

The Third Rail records contain issues of Bunker Hill Community College's student newspaper *The Third Rail*. The materials are dated from 1973 to 2001 and consists primarily of newspaper issues of *The Third Rail*, its predecessor, *The Monument*, and two issues of "*The Third Rail* 2." The issues provide insight into events that occurred at BHCC through student journalism. Topics include BHCC administration policy changes, proposed higher education changes in Massachusetts during the 1980s, faculty and school budget cuts, issues with student parking, and news regarding BHCC presidents from President Shively to the early years of President Fifield's tenure. There are notable gaps in the collection; Box 7, which contains the 1988 issues, is missing; gaps in the volume numbering between the 1974 and 1975 years show that there are issues missing; pages are missing in some 1976 and 1979 issues; and 1983 and 1984 are also missing issues. The materials exist in three primary formats - newspaper, microfilm, and PDF files on a USB flash drive. The issues also exist virtually in a digital archive.
