Scope and Contents

This record group documents various catalogs published at Bunker Hill Community College from 1973 to 2025. The materials include college catalogs, credit course catalogs, and non-credit Community Education catalogs. The materials in the collection are textual consisting primarily of booklets and books; additional formats include brochures, pamphlets, flyers, newspapers, and stapled paper documents.

This collection is arranged into three series; the content of each series is arranged chronologically.

Collection Inventory

Series 1: BHCC College Catalogs

The first series consists of College Catalogs from 1974 to 2019. The catalogs were created by the Integrated Marketing and Communications department, with additional contributions from Enrollment Services. It is unknown what department was responsible for the early college catalogs. The catalogs feature student resources and admission information, degree programs and certificates, and course descriptions. The materials are primarily textual, consisting entirely of books.
