## **Scope and Contents**

# **Collection Inventory**

#### **Series 1: Student Magazines**

This series consists of various student magazines published by different student organizations throughout BHCC's history. The contents of most of the magazines are predominantly textual and consist of student writings such as essays, prose, poetry, and in some cases graphic art and photography. The writings are compiled in magazines and booklets. This series is arranged alphabetically.

Included in this series are the *Kaleidoscope* and *TELL* magazines. *Kaleidoscope* was a compilation of Honors English 111 student essays inspired by an overarching theme given to the students. *TELL* is an ongoing literary magazine published each semester that features contributions from faculty and students that is created and published by the students of English 234 – Literary Publishing. #### **Series 2: Student Newsletters**

The second series consists of various student newsletters created by different student organizations between 1984 to 2025. Newsletters included in the series are the ESL News from the Hill Learning Community's *News from the Hill*; the African American Cultural Society's *Black Voices* newsletter; and the BHCC Ethnic Minority Student Association's *The Rising Tide of Minority Voices*.
