Scope and Contents

The Grant Records record group includes materials from 1978 to 2018 related to the various state and federal grants Bunker Hill Community College applied to and received. The grants primarily represented in this record group are the federal Title III, Title VI, and Perkins grants, with additional grants appearing in the sixth series. The materials cover all aspects of the grant process which include: proposals for applications, progress reports, and final reports on the completed projects. A large portion of the record group is composed of proposals from BHCC faculty/staff to grant committees on campus, but there are also meeting materials, reports, and communications. Some grant-funded projects that appear frequently in the records are Arts Alive and the International Certificate projects under Title VI and the Transitioning for Diverse Learners and LifeMap projects under Title III.

Arrangement

This collection is arranged into 6 series and 25 sub-series.

Series 1: Mini-Grant Paperwork by Year (RG013.01)

The first series consists of seven sub-series, each containing mini-grant paperwork from a year between 1994 and 2007. Many of these records were created by members of the Mini-Grant Committee, and a large portion of them are award letters from the committee to the faculty and staff members chosen to receive minigrants. Other documents include reports on mini-grant projects, policies for applications, and communications between members of the committee and the BHCC community. All these records are in text-based formats.

Series 2: Mini-Grant Proposals and Reports (RG013.02)

The second series is made up of nine sub-series, and the contents range from 1994 to 2011. This series consists of proposals that BHCC faculty and staff created and submitted to the Mini-Grant Committee for grant-funded projects, and there are also reports following the completion of the approved projects. The mini-grant projects represented in this series varied greatly, ranging from requests for course materials, suggestions for new courses, the creation of new programs on campus, funding for professional development, and more. All the items are in text-based formats like bound reports, memos, and proposal forms.

Series 3: Title III (RG013.03)

The third series is spread across eleven folders and a binder, and it contains Title III grant materials from 1988 to 2018. Title III grants are awarded by the U.S. Department of Education to institutions with the purpose of strengthening the finances, programs, and organization of institutions. Many of these records were created by the Title III task force as they oversaw the grant application process within the college.

Types of materials include the applications to the U.S. Department of Education, reports on progress/achievements with grant funds, communications from and within the task force, and meeting minutes and agendas. Some projects using Title III grant funds that are represented in the records include the Engaged Campus, LifeMap, and Classroom Action Research (CAR). All the materials are in text-based formats.

The fourth series is made up of six folders and one binder. These records span 1988 to 1999 but most of the documents are from 1988-1989 and 1999-2000. Title VI grants are awarded by the U.S. Department of Education to institutions with the purpose of improving international and foreign language education. Many of the materials in this series center around the creation of an International Studies certificate and other foreign language programs using grant funding. The formats of these records are all text-based, which includes letters, proposals, reports, memorandums, agendas, and minutes.

Series 5: Perkins Grants (RG013.05)

The fifth series consists of nine sub-series with records that range from 1997 to 2018. All these materials relate to the Perkins Grant, which is a federal grant created by the U.S. Department of Education to award funds to educational institutions with the goal of improving career and technical education. The records in this series are largely proposals from faculty members to the Perkins Mini-grant Committee, with additional reports created after the competition of projects, communications from the committee or faculty members applying for grants, informative handouts and presentations, and meeting materials.
