## Become a Phlebotomist

Phlebotomy Technician Program prepares professionals to collect blood specimens from clients for the purpose of laboratory analysis.

### National Certification

Students who complete this program will have the opportunity to pursue the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) Phlebotomy Technician (CPT) Exam.

### Clinical Externship

This program includes a 40-hour clinical externship opportunity. To be eligible for the clinical, students must successfully complete the 90-hour program, submit to a thorough background check, drug screening and meet other requirements

The purpose of this course is to familiarize the student with all aspects related to blood collection and develop comprehensive skills to perform venipunctures completely and safely. Classroom and lab work includes terminology, anatomy and physiology; blood collection procedures; specimen hands-on practice; and training in skills and techniques to perform puncture methods.

A hybrid version of this course is also offered. The hybrid option allows you to take the "classroom" portion remotely via pre-recorded and live webinar sessions. Students will be assigned to a clinical setting at a later date and upon completion of the training. Students who take an online course should be self-motivated to and have access to the internet. Upon registration, students will be mailed their materials. Students may begin the online course once as soon as they receive their course instructions by email. They can begin their course in advance of receiving their materials. The online portion of the course is approximately 180 hours and most students will complete their certification in 8-16 weeks. Labs will take place at a later date once the College resumes face-to-face classes or students will be assigned an externship placement.
