Roles and Responsibilities

Emergency Management Team (EMT)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activate to support the Campus Community • Coordinate with first responders and medical personnel • Activate the Psychological Crisis Annex
Public Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain perimeter and restrict unauthorized access to the facility • Coordinate emergency vehicle access to the campus • Liaison to first responders
Public Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coordinate all emergency communication platforms • Liaise with the media • Implement the EMT communications strategy • Evaluate communications and record for future reference.

Scope

BHCC has limited capacity to deal with a Mass Casualty Incident and would rely on state and local first responders and medical professionals.
